

Christmas For Kids 2025 INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions have changed! Please read carefully and save for future reference.

What You Need to Know:

- **Children must live in the Moscow School District.** If you live in Latah County outside of Moscow, contact your school district for your local Sharing Tree information.
- **This program is for families in need. Our resources are limited.** If your children will have a nice Christmas without our help, please consider not applying so that we may help other families in greater need.
- Applications received before Nov. 15th will be given priority consideration. Applications received after Nov. 15th will be accepted based on our resources. Apply early!
- Children are eligible up through their senior year in high school, or age 18.

Helpful Tips:

- Print legibly in black or blue ink only. Do not use pencil.
- Sizes can include (T)oddler, (B)oys, (G)irls, (J)uniors, (M)ens or (W)omens if unclear.
- Under "Interests" additional information is welcome, such as favorite color, type of music, sport team, characters, type of cosmetics.
- We do not provide expensive electronic items, designer clothing brands, inappropriately rated video games, etc. so do not list these.
- If you have more than 4 children, fill out the back side of a 2nd application and submit the pages together.

After you've filled out your application:

- Mail your application to the address below. You may email it, but we do not accept photos/scans via cellphone. Scans by a flatbed scanner are acceptable. We also have a fillable form online that you can submit via our website.
- We will contact you in November when your application has been accepted.
- You will receive information between Dec. 1 - 10 regarding when & where to pick up your gifts. We require you to confirm that you will arrive on your assigned pick up day/time, so please check your spam email folder, your voicemail, text messages, etc for a message after Dec. 1.
- Your pick-up day will be between Dec. 15 - 22.
